tolerant, good fall color

'PURPLE PRINCE'**
Bronze leave, rose red
flower, maroon fruit

MEDIUM



YELLOWWOOD
Rounded, slow-growing,
fragrant white flowers,
small seedpods



HONEYLOCUST
Earl leaf out, greenish
yellow flowers - native



**OHIO
BUCKEYE**
Earl leaf out, greenish
yellow flowers - native



**AMERICAN
HOPORNBEAM**
Shade tolerant, lovely
yellow fall color

LARGE



**LONDON
PLANETREE**
Disease/frost resistant,
strong central leader



**NORTHERN
CATALPA**
Oval shape, white flowers,
cigar seedpods



HACKBERRY
Irregular form, corky bark,
tolerates adverse conditions



**SWAMP
WHITE OAK**
Long lived, tolerates
wet or dry soil



**LINDEN
'AMERICAN SENTRY'**
Narrower pyramidal shape,
white flowers, yellow in fall

Mulch 'volcanoes' piled up against tree trunks are harmful to trees, causing decay of the bark that leads to bigger issues – even the death of your tree.

Make doughnuts, not volcanoes.
The root flare of the tree should be visible.
Mulch should be 3 inches away from the trunk, 3 inches deep, and in a 3-foot ring around the tree. Your trees will thank you!
