HACKBERRY Irregular form, corky bark, tolerates adverse conditions



SWAMP WHITE OAK Long lived, tolerates wet or dry soil



LINDEN 'AMERICAN SENTRY' Narrower pyramidal shape, white flowers, yellow in fall



Mulch 'volcanoes' piled up against tree trunks are harmful to trees, causing decay of the bark that leads to bigger issues – even the death of your tree.

Make doughnuts, not volcanoes. The root flare of the tree should be visible. Mulch should be 3 inches away from the trunk, 3 inches deep, and in a 3-foot ring around the tree. Your trees will thank you!
