  - Yard Waste moves to first Mondays in 2026. It will be also be collected 3rd Mondays in Apr-May-Jun and Sep-Oct-Nov.

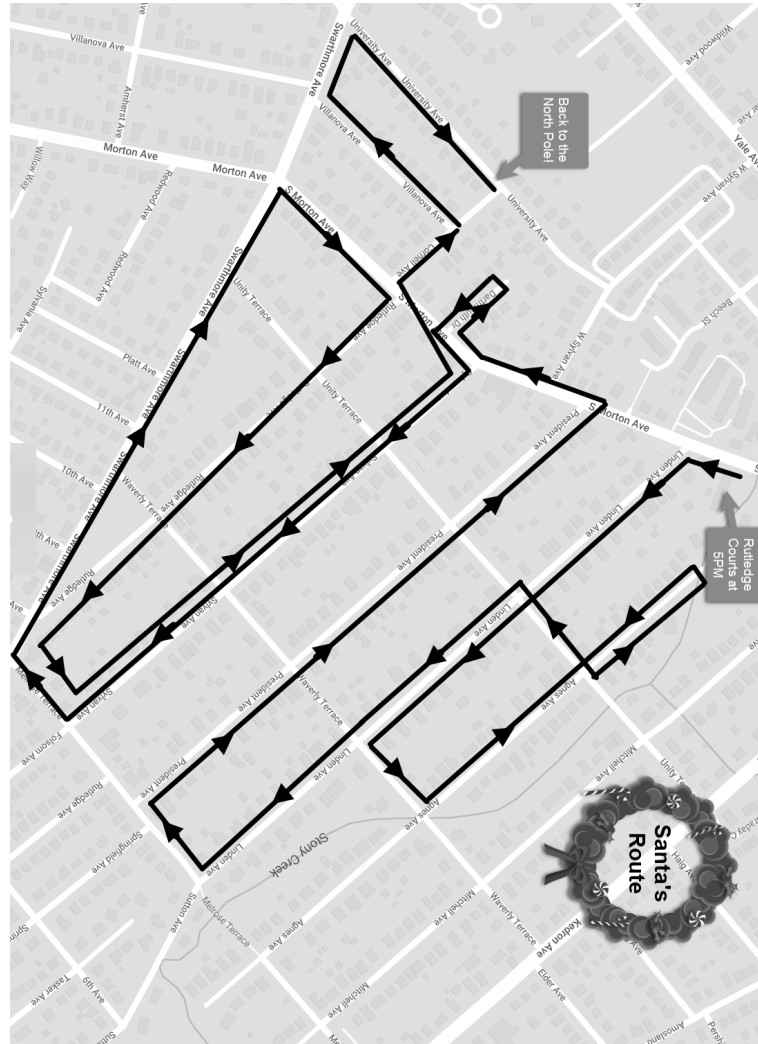
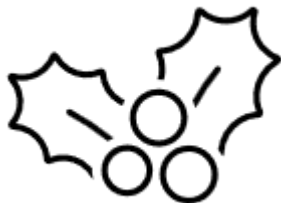
